Category	Description	Marks
Clinical practice and career to date	Undergraduate performance; awards; evidence of progression and achievements, commensurate with the length of time in training	20
Postgraduate degrees and qualifications	Memberships, certificate, diplomas, research-based degrees	20
Clinical audit and dissemination of research	Audit, publications, presentations, posters, audit	20
Teaching, leadership and management	Teaching experience; higher qualification in teaching; evidence of leadership or management role	15
Interest and commitment to a career in public health medicine*	Demonstration of interest and knowledge of PHM and population health approach; experience in specialty or a related specialty	25

Public Health HST Interview Scoring

Category	Description	Marks
Career to date	Undergraduate performance, awards, post-graduate degrees. Evidence that achievements and performance are commensurate with the length of time in training	20
Research and audit	Publications, presentations, posters, audit	20
Teaching, leadership and management	Experience with teaching; higher qualification in teaching; evidence or leadership or a management role	20
Commitment to Public Health Medicine	Enquiries, networking, attendance at scientific meetings; knowledge of what is involved in a career in the specialty	20
Experience relevant to a career in Public Health Medicine	Work in a public health setting, internationally or in Ireland; experience in a related specialty; research, audit, or postgraduate training relevant to the specialty	20
