



FIXED TERM TRAINING APPOINTMENTS

The Institute of Obstetricians & Gynaecologists, in conjunction with the Irish Committee for Higher Medical Training is making available a number of Fixed Term Training Appointments, commencing 1st July 2010. This post is designed to provide top up training for those doctors who are not part of the Specialist Registrar Training Programme and who have not been successful in their application for entry to the Specialists Division of the Register of the Medical Council of Ireland.

PLEASE NOTE:

Decisions concerning eligibility for the Specialist Register are taken by the Medical Council. Appointment to an FTTA post is not a guarantee of success in any future application for Specialist Registration.

ESSENTIAL ENTRY CRITERIA

- Candidates who wish to apply must have at least two year's assessed and approved Basic Specialist Training.
- Candidates must have a minimum of two year's experience as a Registrar post MRCPI/MRCOG or equivalent.
- An application will be considered incomplete if all the information, as hereunder, has not been given:
 1. 10 copies of a completed Application Form
 2. A certified copy of a current Medical Council of Ireland Registration Certificate
 3. A certified copy of a Basic Specialist Training certificate
 4. A certified copy of MRCPI/MRCOG certificate
 5. Application fee of €100 (non refundable)
 6. Two references in a signed, sealed envelope

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

This appointment cannot result in the award of a CSCST, the ICHMT's Certificate of Satisfactory Completion of Supervised Training. Instead, this appointment will be held for a pre-determined period of up to two years with the intention of providing for a specific and limited training need, such as the acquisition of more advanced procedural skills, or some other form of "top-up" training.

Selection will be made following an assessment of the applicant's potential to derive benefit from the training available and will depend on a suitable post becoming vacant.

Short-listed candidates will be asked to attend an interview, at which the objectives and duration of the training period will be discussed in detail and agreed, prior to commencement.
