



**Approved Academic Training in Occupational Medicine**  
**(UAE University, Al Ain)**

Prof Tar-Ching Aw and his team (Dr. John Schneider, Dr. Tom Loney, adjunct and guest lecturers) provide a week-long course in occupational medicine at least annually in Al-Ain, UAE. This is usually organized in February/March before the Faculty of Occupational Medicine, RCPI [FOM] exams held in May each year. Al-Ain is a designated overseas centre for the Licentiate and Membership exams of the FOM.

The course includes sessions on occupational health practice, clinical occupational medicine, toxicology, epidemiology, occupational hygiene, and other topics specified by the FOM syllabus. Course attendees are provided with a copy of Pocket Consultant: Occupational health, 5<sup>th</sup> edition – by Aw, Gardiner, and Harrington. A combination of different teaching methods are used to deliver the course materials, e.g. didactic lectures, case-studies, and interactive exercises. [Other international venues for the course have been used, and are being planned, e.g. Suriname, Qatar]
