Licentiate of the Faculty of Occupational Medicine (LFOM)

Candidates wishing to become a Licentiate of the Faculty of Occupational Medicine must

- i. hold a medical qualification acceptable to the Faculty and College,
- ii. have completed 2 years (full-time equivalent) experience following full registration and
- iii. have completed an academic course of at least 200 hours (25 days) in Occupational Medicine approved by the Faculty.
- iv. The **LFOM examination** consists of a written section, an oral section and a dissertation and is usually held in Dublin and Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. For further details, contact the **Examinations Office** .

Membership of the Faculty of Occupational Medicine (MFOM)

Candidates wishing to become a member of the Faculty of Occupational Medicine must

- i. hold a medical qualification acceptable to the Faculty and College
- ii. have completed 4 years (full-time equivalent) experience following full registration, i.e. 2 years General Professional Training and 2 years satisfactory experience in Occupational Medicine and
- iii. must have completed an academic course of at least 400 hours (50 days) in Occupational Medicine approved by the Faculty.

The **MFOM examination** consists of a written section, a clinical section, an oral section and a dissertation and is usually held in Dublin and Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. For further details, contact the **Examinations Office**.
