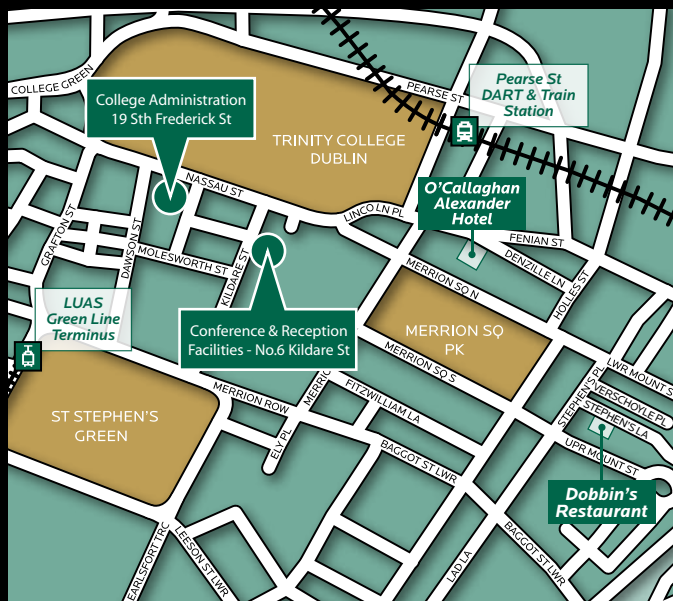

Directions from Dublin Airport by Taxi
