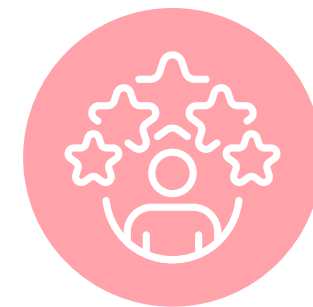

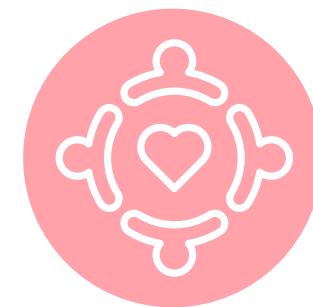

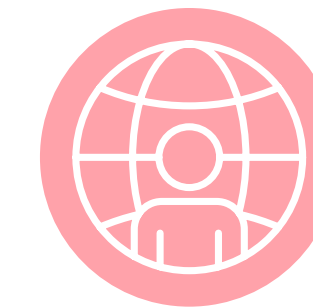

You can take Part II Written through remote invigilation. No need to travel to an examination centre, you can take this examination from anywhere in the world at your own computer.



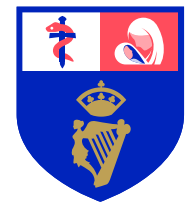

International medical graduates can apply for full registration with a licence to practise in the UK if they hold MRCPI in Obstetrics and Gynaecology.



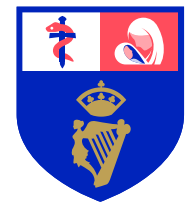

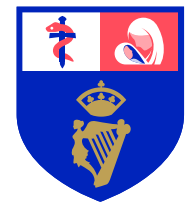

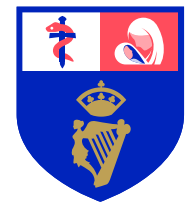


MRCPI in Obstetrics and Gynaecology Part II

EXAM FORMAT

Written – Computer-based Test
via Remote Invigilation



- One paper of 100 Single Based Answer Questions
- 3 hours to complete the examination
- Held twice a year

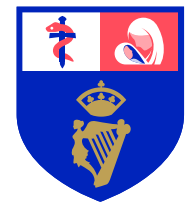

EXAM FORMAT

MRCPI in Obstetrics and Gynaecology Part II OSCE/Clinical



It consists of an Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE) and a Clinical Examination: The **OSCE and Clinical exam** test your knowledge and understanding of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, as well as problem-solving, diagnosis, investigation, treatment, clinical and communication skills.

- *Held twice a year in Ireland and three times a year in the Gulf Region*
- *One examination centre in Ireland and four examinations centres across UAE, Oman and Saudi Arabia*

The OSCE

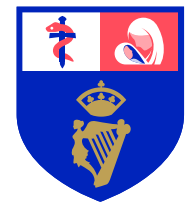
- *It has seven ten-minute stations including a communications station*
- *It has at least one rest station*

The Clinical Examination

- *It consists of one simulated clinical case of 25 minutes in duration in either Obstetrics or Gynaecology*
- *You will use model equipment and interact with a role player*
- *You will take a history and examine the equipment/role player before discussing the case with the examiners*
- *It is fully observed by two examiners*

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Before you can sit the MRCPI in Obstetrics and Gynaecology Written Examination, you must have one of the following qualifications:

- RCPI Professional Diploma in Obstetrics and Gynaecology (*only awarded from 2022 on*)
- MRNFCOG (New Zealand)
- MRCOG Part 1 (*exemption from MRCOG Part 1 is not accepted*)
- FCOG (South Africa)
- MRCPI Part 1 (General Medicine or Paediatrics) obtained within last six years
- FCPS (O&G) (Pakistan)
- MRACOG (Australia)
- MRANZCOG
- MMed (O&G) (Malaysia) – 2008 onwards only

If you have been awarded this Diploma from 2022 onwards, you may apply to sit MRCPI in O&G Part II Written examination. We do not offer an MRCPI Part I in Obstetrics and Gynaecology.

Candidates must have completed 18 months of post-registration training in recognised posts, nine months in Obstetrics and nine months in Gynaecology (or in combined posts). The posts must be recognised by the Institute of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists at RCPI, at least six months in duration and completed by January before the March examination, or by August before the September examination.

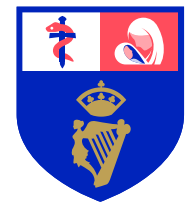
