Nomination Guidelines

The Trainer of the Year Award recognises the high standard of training, support and leadership provided by trainers in RCPI. It is an initiative of the Trainees Committee to reward and encourage successful trainer-trainee relationships.

Eligible Candidates

RCPI- registered trainers are eligible for nomination for the award.

Nomination Guidelines

Trainees are invited to nominate a trainer, under whom they have worked within the preceding 12 months. Please include a brief (2000 character) paragraph explaining why you feel your Trainer deserves this award. Particular examples of mentorship, education and advocacy should be included. Only one nominee per Trainee will be accepted. Trainers may be nominated more than once.

Closing Date

Nominations must be received by **midnight, Monday 20 April 2026**

Awards Ceremony

The award will be announced at the National Education Day for Doctors in Training on Friday, 22 May 2026, along with shortlisted nominees.
