Rehabilitation Medicine HST Shortlisting Criteria

After meeting eligibility criteria:

Category	Description	20 Marks*
Professional Qualifications/Education/Achievements	Undergraduate performance, teaching awards, higher degrees. Professional and Extracurricular achievements.	5
Clinical Practice	Adequate exposure and experience in speciality such as neurology/palliative care/neurology/stroke/psychiatry/trauma/medicine for elderly/primary care	5
Interest/motivation in rehabilitation and Leadership & Management Experience	Candidate demonstrates that they have held a leadership or management role eg. Lead NCHD, hospital committee membership, organising membership examinations, audit or quality improvement programmes. Candidate demonstrates interpersonal skills and experience of working in teams, ability to self-direct learning.	5
Publication & Audit Experience	Publications, specialty publications, presentations, posters, audit, quality improvement programmes	2.5
Teaching Experience	Candidate demonstrates experience with teaching or higher qualification in teaching	2.5
